Step 1 12 Weeks Out

- Make a list of everything you own.** Go room by room and write down or photograph everything, especially valuable or oversized items.
- Decide 'keep' or 'get rid of' — and decide right away.** Handle each item once. Choose keep or get-rid-of on the spot — no 'maybe' pile.
- Fill a trash or recycle bin every week.** Each week, put out a full bin of things you are letting go. Not full means you are not done.
- Talk to two or three real estate agents.** Only if you own your home. Talk to 2–3 agents; ask about price, marketing, fees, and updates.

Step 2 11 Weeks Out

- Start selling things and booking donation pickups.** Sell easy items, book charity pickups, maybe hold a garage sale. Less to move means lower cost.
- Keep getting rid of things, one room at a time.** Keep going room by room with the two rules: decide once, and fill a bin every week.
- Get rough price quotes for your move (do not book yet).** Get ballpark prices for a truck, a container, and full-service movers. Estimates only — do not book.
- Compare the agents you talked to.** Only if you own your home. Weigh each agent's record, plan, price, and fee. You pick one next week.

Step 3 10 Weeks Out

- Hire your real estate agent.** Only if you own your home. Pick the agent you trust most; their price sets your budget.
- Set your moving budget and choose how you will move.** Combine your list, last week's prices, and (if selling) sale money. Pick a method — do not book yet.
- Start the home repairs and updates your agent suggested.** Only if you own your home. Start repairs, updates, and staging early — it helps it sell for more.
- Keep selling and getting rid of things.** Keep working room by room — fill the bin, and move your 'get rid of' pile out.

Step 4 9 Weeks Out

- Get rid of big items before you get your price quote.** Move out the big things you are letting go, so next week's quote matches what you will really move.
- Get your home ready to list for sale.** Only if you own your home. Finish repairs and staging. A stored container can bridge date gaps.
- Make a final push to sell, then donate the rest.** Sell or give away what is left; send the rest to a donation pickup.

The heart of a smart move: don't pay to move what you'd replace for less. Moving everything — even cheap, replaceable furniture — often costs more to haul than to buy new at the other end. Move what is worth moving, and use these two rules:

- **The "get rid of it" rule.** Handle each item once and decide on the spot. Ask: would it cost more to move this than to replace it later? If yes, let it go — especially cheap flat-pack furniture.
- **The "full bin every week" rule.** Put out a full trash or recycle bin every week. If it is not full, you have not gotten rid of enough yet.
